Homework

Labs

The lab will be an integral part of the class. **There is a \$10.00 lab fee due the first two weeks of school.** After completing a lab, each student will be required to turn in a neatly produced lab report. This report will be due at the ending of the class period. If a student misses a lab, credit will be given after consulting with the teacher and determining a suitable make-up assignment

Tests and Quizzes

Tests will be given at the end of each unit. If you are aware of a problem that will occur on a test day, ***talk with me before the test, not after!*** If you miss a test and it is not made up, then you will receive a zero. ***At the end of the quarter, if you have no more than a total of 2 tardies or absences (including those made up in attendance school), the low test/quiz score will be dropped.*** Quizzes announced and unannounced will be given. A cumulative final (multiple choice questions) will be given at the end of every quarter. This final is worth 10% of the grade.
